You are hereby commanded to summon George B. Shapson
to appear before the judge of our next Circuit Court to
be holden for the County of Montgomery at the Court House
in the Town of Clarksville on the 2^d Monday in September
next. That said Shapson to answer Moses A. Fountain in a
plea of Covenant broken to his damage Five hundred & 00
Dollars. Merin fail not, and have them show this writ.
Witness Myself Bailiff Clerk of our said Court at office
in the Town of Clarksville the 2^d Monday in May 1820
56th year of the independence of the United States

Moses A. Fountain by attorney complains of George W. Stinson who has been summoned to answer No. of a plea of Covenant broken that he owes unto him the sum of two hundred & twenty three Dollars & twenty five cents which to him he owes from him he unjustly detains. For that whereas the said deft on the 24th Sept 1839 at the County aforesaid Executed made his certain Covenant under seal & delivered the same to the plaintiff which is to the Court herein shown the date & the day in the said day year aforesaid. Whereof he Covenanted bound himself ninety days after date to pay to Moses A. Fountain in current Bank Money of the State of Mississippi the sum of two hundred & twenty three Dollars & twenty five cents for services rendered in the year 1838. And for that whereas the said defendant Stinson found on the 24th Sept 1839. at the County aforesaid Executed made his Covenant in writing under seal and delivered the same to the plaintiff which is to the Court herein shown the date whereof is the same day year aforesaid whereof he Covenanted bound himself ninety days after the date of said Covenant to pay the said plaintiff the sum of two hundred & twenty three Dollars & 75 cents for value recd. Yet the said plaintiff says the defendant has not kept & performed his Covenant aforesaid. but has broken the same in this. To-wit. that he did not ninety days after the date of said Covenant, or at any time thereafter as yet pay to the said plaintiff the said sum of two hundred & twenty three Dollars & 75 cents, or any part thereof. nor has the said defendant as yet paid the said plaintiff the said sum of two hundred & twenty three Dollars & twenty five cents in current Bank Money of the State of Mississippi or any part thereof. but the same to pay, or any part thereof he has as yet wholly failed refused & still fails refuses so to do to plaintiffs damages four hundred Dollars therefore he sues
